### THIS WEEK'S LESSON: NO ROOM



#### IN THE CAR:

Ask your child what they learned about this week on the drive home:

Mary and Joseph endured a long journey from Nazareth to Bethlehem, only to find that there was no room in the whole town for them to stay. With Jesus on the way, they had to take shelter in a barn to welcome their baby into the world. Luke 2:1-20, The Birth of Jesus



#### HANGING OUT:

Make this week's lesson real:

Ask your kids how they would feel if they had no place to sleep on Christmas Eve. How could knowing the story of Jesus give them peace even in that moment? Say a prayer for everyone who won't have a safe place to sleep this Christmas.



#### AT DINNER:

Here are some great discussion starters:

- How do you think Mary and Joseph felt when there was no room in the inn?
- How does the birth of Jesus give us peace?
- How can we help spread God's peace this holiday season?



#### AT BEDTIME:

Quiz your child on this week's memory verse:

*"The Lord himself will give you a sign. The virgin is going to have a baby. She will give birth to a son. And he will be called Immanuel." Isaiah 7:14 (NIRV)*



#### PARENT TIME:

What you need to know:

Mary and Joseph had to spend their first night as parents in a stable, but even there, they felt the peace of God. Say a prayer and ask God to show you how you and your kids can share the peace of God this Christmas.

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
