THIS WEEK'S LESSON: THE TALE OF TWO KINGS



IN THE CAR:

Ask your child what they learned about this week on the drive home:

When King Herod learned that a new king had been born, he became jealous and angry. He asked the Magi to lead him to Jesus, but God made sure that didn't happen. Matthew 2:1-11, The Visit of the Magi



HANGING OUT:

Make this week's lesson real:

Ask your kids what made Jesus so special. Why was His birth in a stable so important to us that we celebrate it today?



Here are some great discussion starters:

- Why did the wise men seek Jesus?
- Why did an angel warn the wise men not to tell King Herod where Jesus was?
- How is Jesus more powerful than any earthly king?



AT BEDTIME:

Quiz your child on this week's memory verse:

"The Lord himself will give you a sign. The virgin is going to have a baby. She will give birth to a son. And he will be called Immanuel." Isaiah 7:14 (NIrV)



PARENT TIME:

What you need to know:

Herod was a powerful man, but God is more powerful than any man. We can trust Jesus completely, even with our lives, because He is the King of Kings!
