THIS WEEK'S LESSON: THE GREAT ESCAPE



IN THE CAR:

Ask your child what they learned about this week on the drive home:

King Herod was now fully determined to kill the baby king. He sent soldiers to Bethlehem to carry out his orders. But Joseph was able to take his family to Egypt with little time to spare. The life of the baby Jesus had to be saved, so that Jesus could grow up and give his life so that we could be saved. Matthew 2:11-20, The Escape to Egypt



HANGING OUT:

Make this week's lesson real:

Ask your kids how Jesus can help us to escape from sin.



AT DINNER:

Here are some great discussion starters:

- Why did Mary and Joseph flee to Egypt?
- What does God want us to flee from?
- How can Jesus set us free from sin?



AT BEDTIME:

Quiz your child on this week's memory verse:

PARENT TIME:

What you need to know:
